Requisitos impuestos por el Reino Unido para la entrada en su país

Dear partners,

The UK Government is introducing an Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA) for travellers entering the UK for up to six months. This change will impact students who could previously enter the UK as a visitor without applying for a visa in advance. This includes, but is not limited to, EU, EEA, US, Canadian, Australian and Japanese nationals.

Students coming to the UK for a full academic year, or full calendar year, will still need to apply for a Student Visa. They do not need an ETA as well.

For Spring semester 2025, a number of nationalities are being added to the ETA list, meaning that if they are going to enter the UK after 8 January 2025, they will need to apply for an ETA, which they can do from the 27 November 2024.

From 2 April 2025, all non-visa nationals will be required to apply for an ETA before visiting the UK. This means that all students who could previously enter the UK without applying for a visa will need an ETA for the Autumn 2025 intake.
